ACTION ITEMS:

- 1. <u>Investments</u>: Mr. Bounds reported on discussion on additional private debt to asset allocation, which has a higher return than traditional Bonds. One way to increase allocation to this class would be to add to existing investments, being a \$6M investment in PADCOF III (Portfolio Advisors). (At the Annual Meeting, Meketa would have recommended this investment in an overall discussion of asset allocation.) Upon motion by Trustee Cabello Havrda and second by Trustee Sanchez, the Board unanimously approved the investment in PADCOF as recommended by Meketa.
- 2. Personnel/ Audit: None.

3. Benefits:

- a. <u>COVID Vaccine</u>: The Vaccine is still not available at clinics. Members are encouraged to use one of the 4 locations (UHS; COSA; Well-Med; and UTHSC).
- b. <u>Telemedicine Coverage</u>: Upon motion by Trustee Sanchez and second by Trustee Perez, the availability/use of telemedicine was continued to members through end of May, 2021. Staff was requested to schedule discussion on pros and cons of telemedicine for future care.
